Grand Kakalin Project Wins Prominent Economic Development Award

Madison, WI – The Grand Kakalin development project in Kaukauna won the Public-Private Partnership Award at the 4th annual Community and Economic Development Awards (CEDA) banquet, held September 12, 2018, at The Edgewater Hotel in Madison. The CEDA Awards program was established by the Wisconsin Economic Development Association (WEDA) to recognize businesses, projects, and organizations that are making significant contributions to Wisconsin’s economy.

The Public-Private Partnership award honors projects, programs or initiatives that have been successful due to exceptional collaboration between the public and private sectors.

“The Grand Kakalin project has not only preserved a piece of our past, it has breathed new life into our downtown district and has had a critical domino effect in creating new jobs and spurring development,” said Randy Stadtmueller, President of Stadtmueller & Associates, the firm that helped develop the project. “Whether as an employee in Kaukauna’s downtown, a pedestrian enjoying the river views, or as a resident visiting the Kaukauna Public Library, the Grand Kakalin project has changed for the better how we interact with the Fox River and our city’s history.”

Thanks to strong collaboration between the developer, Expera Specialty Solutions, the City of Kaukauna and the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation, this project has brought a new and contemporary use to a piece of Wisconsin history.
